EXCITING GALA UPDATE!! POTENTIAL \$25,000 MATCH TO PAY FOR AIR CONDITIONING IN OUR SCHOOL!!

A generous, anonymous donor has volunteered to contribute \$10,000 to our school as a Match Amount! On top of that, we have a \$2,500 contribution from Brad and Melanie Rixmann, the owners of Pawn America and supporters of Lutheran schools. So, in total, we have \$12,500 that will be matched dollar for dollar, with the potential to earn **\$25,000**!

This amount is enough to cover air-conditioning for the Zion School classrooms! Currently, most classrooms do not have a/c, and in the warmer months, they can get very warm for the teachers and students. If we reach our \$25,000 goal, we can upgrade to add air conditioning to those six classrooms, which will immediately benefit our teachers, students, and staff! This could also extend to air conditioning in the gym.
